Luc Martens has been Minister of Culture and Welfare in the Flemish government, member of the Flemish Parliament and of the federal Senate, chair of the parliamentary commission on Welfare, Health and Family and he is still local councilor in his own city of Roeselare. He has a particular interest in strategic planning, urban development, external relations, safety, culture, welfare and education. Luc Martens is member of the CD&V, the Christian Democratic party in Flanders, Belgium.
